



## Have your say on the future of Cannock Wood

Cannock Wood Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Plan which has been submitted to Cannock Chase District Council. Cannock Chase District Council is now consulting on this and invites your comments. **The consultation period runs for 6 weeks from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July until Monday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2023.**

The Neighbourhood Plan contains a number of policies for guiding the future development of the Cannock Wood Neighbourhood Area (the Cannock Wood Parish area). After this consultation the plan has to be sent to an independent examiner who will take account of all information submitted including comments made at this stage. If the examiner finds the plan meets the relevant statutory tests then it can proceed to a referendum which is where the community in the Parish get to vote on whether they want the plan to be adopted by Cannock Chase Council. If the majority vote in favour of the plan then it can be used to help determine planning applications in the area.
